





Compare and Contrast Vocabulary 3 EASY STEPS

- Step 1: Enter compare and contrast signal words and phrases
- Step 2: Select Activity Word List
- Step 3: Click Create Activity and Print and use on your Interactive Whiteboard

Compare and Contrast Lesson Plan

- Create a Word List with compare and contrast signal vocabulary words and phrases*.
- Read examples compare and contrast information text as a whole group; the New York Times is an excellent resource for examples.
- Discuss the text and use a graphic organizer, such as a Venn Diagram, on your whiteboard to document the similarities and differences.
- Instruct students to find real life examples and complete a compare and contrast graphic organizer.
- Instruct students to write a compare and contrast article; provide students a graphic organizer to use in planning their piece.
