

## DEFINITION CARDS

61. Select various numbers to be on the front of the Definition Cards. Have students write the fact families for that number on the back of the card.
62. Use pictures of animals. On the back of the Definition Cards, have the students research the animals and write the Phylum, Species, Class, Family, etc.
63. Use pictures of the 50 states. On the back of the Definition Cards, have the students write the capital, state bird, population, location or any other significant fact.

## POCKET CHART CARDS

64. Print each child's name, various nouns and verbs on Pocket Chart Cards. Using the words of a sentence already placed in a pocket chart, student's can personalize the sentence by removing the existing subject and replacing it with their name, etc. Have the other students talk about the sentence and what that child might see, do or hear.

## OLD MAID

65. Make a set of Old Maid cards using opposites. Each partner will ask, "Do you have the opposite of...?"
